What is the SORM Education Hub?

The SORM Education Hub is an alternative educational provision for vulnerable young adults and some of the hardest to reach young individuals.

The Education Hub began its journey in 2020 during the COVID 19 pandemic providing educational classes via video conferencing software. Since then the Education Hub has grown into a service providing group based music, life skills and cooking classes in house and has recently acquired a new base dedicated to the education provision.

The Education Hub is an education centre specifically aimed at; music production, cooking and life skills.

Here at the Education Hub we pride ourselves on delivering education with an alternative approach ensuring we provide an engaging and supportive environment for our students to learn at their own pace.

The Snug

The Snug is a room that is designed to be based on the students needs during their breaks and is a constant work in progress for our student voice group to decide if there is anything else that may be beneficial to the overall experience of the Education Hub.



DJ Room

The DJ room is a student area setup with DJ decks, music production software and a microphone for students to make use of in their spare time throughout their day.



Life Skills Classroom

The life skills classroom is where the students will take part in subject specific discussions and projects.



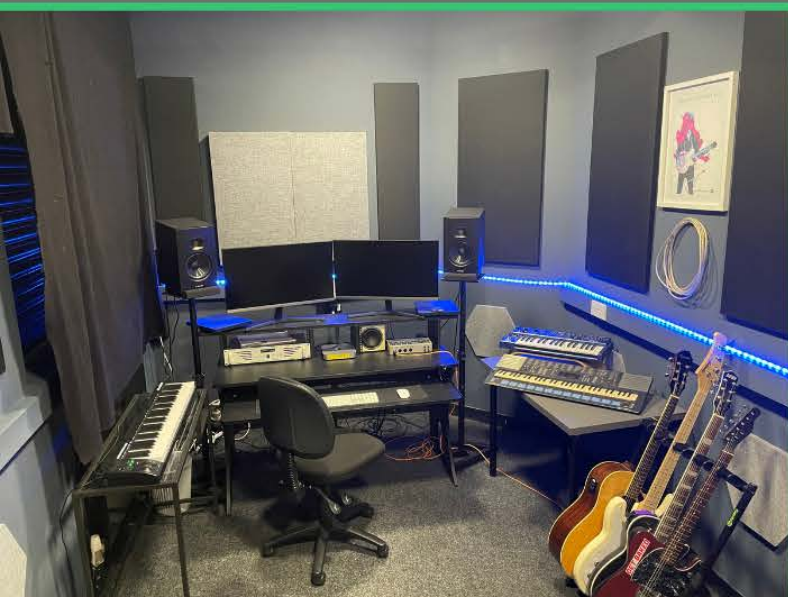
Kitchen Classroom

The kitchen classroom is where our students will take part in preparing/cooking & catering activities whilst also learning the rules and regulations that tie in with working in the food industry.



Music Production Classrooms

We have multiple production classrooms in which our production tutors teach music theory and practical music production.



Music Studio

The music studio is available for students to use throughout the week to fine tune any tracks they have been working on and learn the theory behind how a music studio is setup and how the equipment is used.



Media Room

The media room is where our in house media team work closely with the Bradford Council and other external companies to produce corporate standard quality work. They also work within our organisation managing the website and other media platforms.

What Qualifications/Accreditations do we offer?



We are working with the Skills and Education Group who are the awarding body for all the qualifications/accreditations that our students would undertake in their time at the Education Hub.



The Skills and Education Group offer qualifications and assessments which are regulated by CCEA, Ofqual and Qualifications Wales.

We currently offer the following qualifications/accreditations;

- **Basic Food Preparation and Cooking Entry Level 1**
- **Personal Development Skills Entry Level 1**
- **Personal Development Entry Level 2**
- **Sound and Audio Production Skills Entry Level 1**
- **Sound and Audio Production Skills Intermediate**
- **Using Cooking Skills in the Domestic Kitchen Entry Level 1**

A typical level 1 qualification would equal to 3 credits which would be the equivalent to a GCSE grade D-G and a typical level 2 qualification would be equivalent to a GCSE grade A-C.

How can students access the Education Hub?

For students to enrol on to the Education Hub they would need to have an active EHCP (Educational Health Care Plan), be aged from 16-25 and to be referred to the service by the relevant professional or special educational needs department.

This process can begin by the parent/carer of the young person current school/college provision and making them aware that they would their young person to attend the School of Rock and Media's Education Hub provision.

Once the Education Hub is made aware of the young persons interest in the provision we can arrange for a visit/tour of the building in which the young person can meet the staff team an gain more information about the qualifications and activities they would be undertaking if they were to enrol on to the Education Hub.

The visit/tour stage of the journey allows the young person to make an informed decision about their future in education and whether or not the Education Hub would be the correct service for them.

If the young person would like to enrol after their visit/tour then we would move on to setting up a taster day in which the young person would take part in a mock college day with other new starters to get an idea of what to expect once they begin their course.

What is an EHCP?

An EHCP is a legal document for an individual child or young person aged from 16-25 with special educational needs or disabilities also known as (SEND).

What's in an EHCP?

An EHCP sets out a description of the individuals educational, health and social care needs.

How to get an EHCP?

A parent/carer of the young person would need to reach out to their local authority to request an assessment for an EHCP for the young person.

Where to get support?

For support with the application process for an EHCP contact SENDIASS. They offer free and impartial support to help guide you through the process.

Tours & Tasters

What happens on a tour?

If you arrange a tour at the Education Hub this would be an opportunity to come down and have a look for yourself and really get a feel for the environment and put some faces to names by meeting the staff team.

What happens on a taster?

If you have had a tour and have decided to go ahead and take part in one of our taster sessions this will be a day in which you will be placed into a group of other potential new students and will take part in a mock day of what a typical day in education would entail. We feel this would give the new potential students the best chance of really getting a feel for how the service runs to help them with their final decision.
